

INFORMATION FOR THE PARENTS OF THE PATIENTS ADMITTED
ACCORDING TO A SCHEDULE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PEDIATRIC
CARDIOLOGY

On the day of admission the patient should possess:

1. Documents:

- ∞ referral to the hospital
- ∞ child's health book
- ∞ medical documentation concerning current treatment + other important supplementary documents, if any (ECG, radiological images, CD with computed tomography or magnetic resonance, etc.)

2. Textbooks and notebooks (primary school and junior high school pupils)

The patient should report to the admission room by 9 am

Stay of the carer in the hospital:

Infants and pre-school-age children always stay in the Department of Pediatric Cardiology under the care of their parents (legal guardians), whereas in the case of schoolchildren it is dependent on the patient's wish or current availability of beds intended for parents.

Visits:

The patient can be visited each day, however it is recommended that the visits should not interrupt the course of the treatment of other patients. For that reason no more than 2 persons can visit the child at the same time and the visit itself should not be longer than 1 – 1.5 hours. The above recommendations are applied in a flexible manner convenient to the patient and to the visitors alike.
