

On the day of admission the patient should possess:

1. Documents

- ☞ referral to the hospital
- ☞ NFZ [National Health Fund] card (applicable to patients from the Silesian Province)
- ☞ examination results, X-ray images
- ☞ identity card
- ☞ hospital summary discharge reports
- ☞ child's health book

2. Toiletries:

- ☞ towel
- ☞ toothbrush
- ☞ soap
- ☞ comb
- ☞ shampoo

3. Pyjamas – 2 pairs and slippers

4. Cutlery and mug

5. School equipment for the schoolchildren

6. Disposable nappies and care products for babies

7. Thermometer

To be admitted to hospital, please report to the admission room:

- ☞ between 10:00 am and 12 pm for procedures scheduled for the next day
- ☞ between 2:00 and 3:00 pm on Sunday
- ☞ between 7:00 and 8:00 am for procedures scheduled for the same day

Infections in the case of a procedure to be performed

The child must not suffer from any infectious disease, including nasal congestion, cough, fever or increased body temperature, diarrhoea and subjective symptoms, e.g. weakness, bone aching.

In the case of a contact with persons suffering from an infectious disease a waiting period of at least three weeks is required.

A waiting period of at least 10 days is required after a scheduled vaccination and at least 14 days - after treatment with antibiotics.

Preparation of the patient for the procedure

Infants and small babies – last feeding at 5:00 am (liquid food)

Drinking at 6:00 am on the day of the procedure (water or tea)

Older children – last highly digestible meal at 8 pm, last drinking (water or tea) at around midnight on the day preceding the date of the medical procedure.

The patients admitted for a procedure must be with an empty stomach.

The patient admitted to the hospital department should be bathed, should get his/her hair washed. The child's nails should be short and unpainted and he/she cannot wear any jewellery.

Stay of the carer in the hospital

The carer may stay in the hospital together with the child. The hospital provides camp beds for the parents.
